## Desktop Publishing Graphic Design (AAS.DPGD) Associate in Applied Science Degree

This program is designed to prepare graduates for careers requiring a solid knowledge of desktop publishing. Emphasis is placed on training in current graphic arts software and web page design techniques combined with the latest office technology trends. Students will design and create artwork for commercial publication and see the process through to make it press plate ready. Students may assume positions as fulltime desktop publishers, graphic designers, pre-press operators, or positions involving a blend of administrative office duties and desktop publishing. Some students succeed as freelancers and open their own businesses.

Program requirements may change over time. Specific degree/graduation requirements are determined by the students' degree audit.
